

Care and Maintenance

Smooga panels are made totally from plastics in the UK. The bases are made from re-cycled plastic. They are self weighted to approx 18kg. The top sections are made from High Density Polyethylene (HDPE).

Features

- Heavy recycled base of 18kg base colour gray/black.
- Top section can be supplied in Oxford Blue or Forest Green
- High density (HD) moulded top section can be water filled, which will add a further 15kg.
- Designed for portability and compact stacking
- Anti-tamper, safe linking system
- Can be personalised with school colours and logo in the form of vinyl stickers.
- Recycled and 100% recyclable.
- Designed and manufactured in the UK.
- Performs well in windy conditions up to 30mph

Storage

When moving the panels it is better to remove the top sections from the bases and then stack these separately.

Remove the top sections and store them either flat or standing, leaning against a wall or strong fence. If you are stacking flat and have a spare pallet, stack them on this. Put all these sections the same way round and they will stack more closely together.

When storing the bases they will stack 'inside' each other. Place one base flat on the floor and then invert the next one and put on top. This forms a kind of block and then you can build a stack with a series of blocks. Remember that the bases are heavy and therefore you must be careful not to stack too high. We would recommend a maximum height of 4 bases. Please ensure that children do not play around the stacks or climb on them as they will move. To prevent movement pallet wrap can be wound around the stack to make them more stable.

Cleaning

The Smooga panels can be easily cleaned with soapy water. Do not use an abrasive cleaner or cloth as this can scratch the surface of the top sections. A hose pipe or pressure washer can also be used for cleaning the Smooga panels.
